Principal Updates: Mrs. Spenner,

-school year is going well, school grades received on 8/6- we are a high B, highest rated Elementary school in the district.

-School improvement plan will be voted on today, next year plan to be an A school and exceed growth

- Budget addition idea
 - Teachers receive annual stipend (\$150 per teacher) Emily and Lisa went to Tuesday's staff meeting to share with staff. We're hoping to add more as fundraiser goals are met during the year.
 - Proposing an additional 1 time grade level stipend of \$100, this would be in addition to the classroom teacher stipend. This will be added to the budget. Board vote is unanimous.
- New Spirit Night coordinator vote

- Alana Johnson- In order to make this official we need to vote to put her into place. Board vote is unanimous.
- Grants and Sponsorship- Geoff Oman coordinates banners on the fence at car line. Instead of monthly sponsorships, it is going to be either ½ or Full year sponsorships.
- Ideas for fundraising for school safety- Safety film around all windows, bullet resistant (not bulletproof).. The cost of this will be around \$40,000. Hoping to use sponsorships to help with this cost.
- If anyone has grant writing experience to help with this fundraising let us know.
- Also want to raise funds for a digital sign just for our school, to show events going on and to display sponsorships that we have for the school.
- If we have a company that wants to sponsor different events such as movie nights, we want to do that as well.
- Suggestion was made to create a QR code that could take sponsors to a website for easier access to sponsorships. Lisa will start working on the packages that we can present to the sponsors. Suggestion to extend the fence in order to be able to display more banners. We aren't sure that will be an option but can be explored.

Budget Vote: Katy Hemphill

- Vote on 23/24 Budget, call was made by Lisa to vote on budget. Board unanimously voted on this. Budget is included at the end of this document.
- Kristine K. wants to request more allocation for the HawkFund and less for the Attraction Guide fundraiser. This will be determined once a budget for HawkFund is presented, and can be voted on at the next meeting.

- Spirit wear sales- great sale at open house. Going forward, not going to pre-order adult sizes but they can be ordered. Online orders are not live yet, will reinventory after movie night and will make it live after that time.
